Results don't always show how fast and determined a rider is. Samuel's goal this year was to race at the front and on a few occasions, he was able to be in battles for top 5 finishes...unfortunately some bad luck and last lap passes didn't go as planned! But our experience and speed shown during the races made us want more.



Samuel's current goal is to become the top contenders in the CMRC Quebec / Ontario Junior classes.



At the beginning of the 2011 season, we decided to concentrate our effort on Samuel's riding abilities. We turned our focus to race only on our Honda CR125R. Samuel is working hard on and off the track to stay competitive and his riding techniques have been improving constantly. Any mistake is easily seen on a 125cc bike against 250F and 450F!

Samuel is very motivated to race his 125cc against the competition. And to provide him with the best machinery, we are currently looking at upgrading to a 150cc 2 stroke or adding a 250cc 4 stroke.

We strongly believe in Samuel's potential. He was able to battle for an 11th place finish against 450cc machinery, in junior MX3, while riding his 2002 CR125R. ..Imagine what he could do on equal machinery in 2012!

YEARS IN REVIEW

For 2011, Samuel was aiming to be within the top 10 contenders in the CMRC Quebec Championship Junior MX2, MX3 and schoolboy classes.

The 2010 season was a year where we tested the water on the Provincial level. This was also the first time for Samuel on a full size bike. Samuel highlights during that season were at Ulverton. Samuel's speed and determination on this track was amazing. Even with a multitude of bad luck during the weekend he kept on charging. At every start he was fighting for the holeshot and got push off the track many times. In one qualifier race, he had to retire from a top 5 finish because of a bent brake pedal, even then he came back the next race to finish in 2nd place of the MX2 last chance qualifier.

GOALS

Goals for 2012 are to win races in all the Junior classes, fight for the Eastern Ontario Championship and race the Monster Energy Montreal Supercross in the amateur junior class.

Long term goal is to be a CMRC Intermediate level rider, race at Pro National and qualify for the Montreal Supercross.

- Our family is, when possible, also involved in the Race Club and promoting motocross's growth in our area.
